HUNTING IN MPUMALANGA WITH ROY'S HUNTING SAFARIS

Our concession is just south of Groblersdal in the Mapumalanga Province. It is a mere 2,5 hours drive from OR Tambo International Airport and 2 hours from Pretoria, on safe national and main tarred roads. The last 3kms is good gravel road, ensuring serenity at our lodge overlooking a bass & fish stock dam, secluded by mountains.

The hunting area consists of 1000ha of mixed bushveld, hills, savannah and mountains. Terrain is negotiated easily by vehicle and on foot, with fair visibility as per normal in the bushveld. Game, birdlife and reptiles are plentiful, including indigenous venomous snakes.

Being so well positioned travelling here will be no problem from any other hunting area, from Kruger National Park or Johannesburg. The airfield a only a few miles away. The lodge is set superbly overlooking the dam, lovely veranda, lapa, braai place and private rooms. All is catered for, provide only for your own private commodities.

Game spotting is done by vehicle and hunt on foot. Bow & rifle hunt is done. Your three, very experienced, Professional hunters are Roy Vermaak, Dries Van Wyk (owner) & Eugene Visagie, who is very experienced and has hunted big game all over Africa including Tanzania.
